4. What new housing construction is proposed for police working outside the main urban centres in the 1992-93 financial year.

**ANSWER**

1. At the request of government, negotiations with the Commonwealth have been ongoing for some time, with a view to their long term use of the Supreme Court building. No formal decision has resulted from this process at the present time. In the interim Tourist Bureau staff will be using part of the building.
