What was the overall cost to the Northern Territory tax payer incurred from the additional work and staff required by Territory Families during implementation of the Alice Springs curfew.

## ANSWER:

During the curfew period in Alice Springs, a total of 33 staff of the Department worked a total of 824 hours worked overtime paid to staff. The costs does not include the ordinary hours worked by the employees in the ordinary course of their duties - the below table provides the full additional costing during the period 27 March 2024 and was in effect till 6am, 16 April 2024 (the curfew period).
