## Commonwealth Week | 4 - 8 March 2019

Parliament House is once again teaming up with **Government House** for a special two hour Commonwealth Week program.



One hour of the program will be spent in the Main Hall of Parliament House surrounded by the flags of the 53 Commonwealth countries. Students will do an interactive activity as they 'travel around the world' learning about these member countries. The activity is closely aligned to the History curriculum.

For the second hour of the program, a small morning tea will be provided, as well as a half hour tour of Government House to learn about this beautiful historic building and the role of the Administrator.

The program is **FREE** and **full bus funding is provided.**
