- external positions are those positions which need to be registered onto PIPS but are paid manually if/when required i.e. 52 Board Members and 12 long term workers compensation cases as well as retired Judges, Chief Justices and Director of Public Prosecution.
- full-time casual works at least a full day in a pay period
