Minister, could you give us an indication of how many people are presently working on the prison site and how many of those people are working for local Northern Territory companies?

The Sitzler Baulderstone Joint Venture (SBJV) Local Industry Participation Plan (LIPP) has been developed in consultation with and endorsed by Northern Territory Industry Capability Network (NTICN) in both procurement of local services and verification of achievements.

SBJV has achieved 73 percent local participation through let trades contracts for the period ending 31 May 2013

The number of people on the project has exceeded 900 workers.

Using the LIPP criteria as endorsed by NTICN, and based on an average number of 850 workers on site for May 2013, SBJV records indicate that approximately 82 percent of workers on site can be defined as being locally employed by local subcontractors.
