Answer: Postal Voting at the 2008 Legislative Assembly Election

The number of postal ballot papers issued to electors at the 2008 Legislative Assembly General Election was 4072.

This number included 1154 registered postal voters (remote, silent address, infirm, carer electors etc) to whom ballot papers are despatched as soon as they have been printed and processed.

The report into the August 2008 Legislative Assembly elections will provide detailed analysis of postal voting.
