Answer:

Refurbishment work is continuing across the Territory's smaller remote communities.

The communities that have already received refurbishment works under SIHIP may be considered for additional refurbishment works, following assessment of other communities housing needs, which will be addressed in the first instance.

The property management program, significantly ramped up in recent years, will continue to focus on improving the functionality and amenity of all houses in each community, including those that may not have received refurbishment work under SIHIP.
