Mrs. Finocchiaro to the Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services:

Workplace health and safety

- 1. What has been the cost of the stress related claims received by the agency during 2017/18?
- 2. What roles are these people undertaking?
- 3. How much time was lost due to those claims that were accepted?
- 4. How many employees remain on leave due to stress?
- 5. How many claims of bullying were lodged by employees of the agency during 2017/18?
- 6. What action has been taken as a result of these claims?
- 7. How many claims are outstanding?

ANSWERS:

- 1. The total expenditure for 2017 / 2018 that relates to claims for exposure to mental stress \$7,576,105.
- 2. Members with claims for exposure to mental stress who have been certified with medical restrictions are undertaking suitable policing duties. These duties generally do not include general duties.
- 3. Gallagher Bassett are unable to provide data as it relates to time lost.
- 4. As of 30 June 2018, there were 12 Northern Territory Police, Fire and Emergency Services employees covered under workers' compensation that were unfit as a result of a psychological condition.
- 5. During the 2017 / 2018 financial year, five (5) employees lodged a complaint to the Human Resource Management Branch for bullying related behaviour.
- 6. The complaints were investigated and appropriate action was taken based on the findings of the investigations.
- 7. Two (2) complaints remain outstanding and are currently being investigated.
