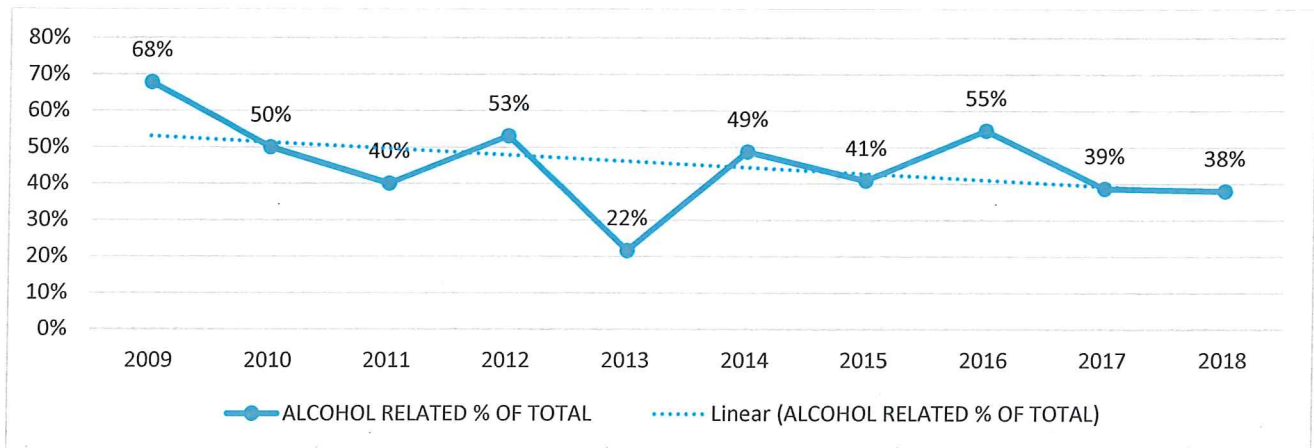

- From 2009 to 2018, 45% of fatalities on NT roads have been alcohol related.
- Males are over-represented in alcohol related road fatalities (73%).
- Aboriginal people are over-represented in alcohol related road fatalities (66%), being only 30% of the population.
- 66% of alcohol related fatalities occur in rural areas. This is in line with total fatalities on NT roads.
- People over the age of 25 represent 79% of alcohol related road fatalities.

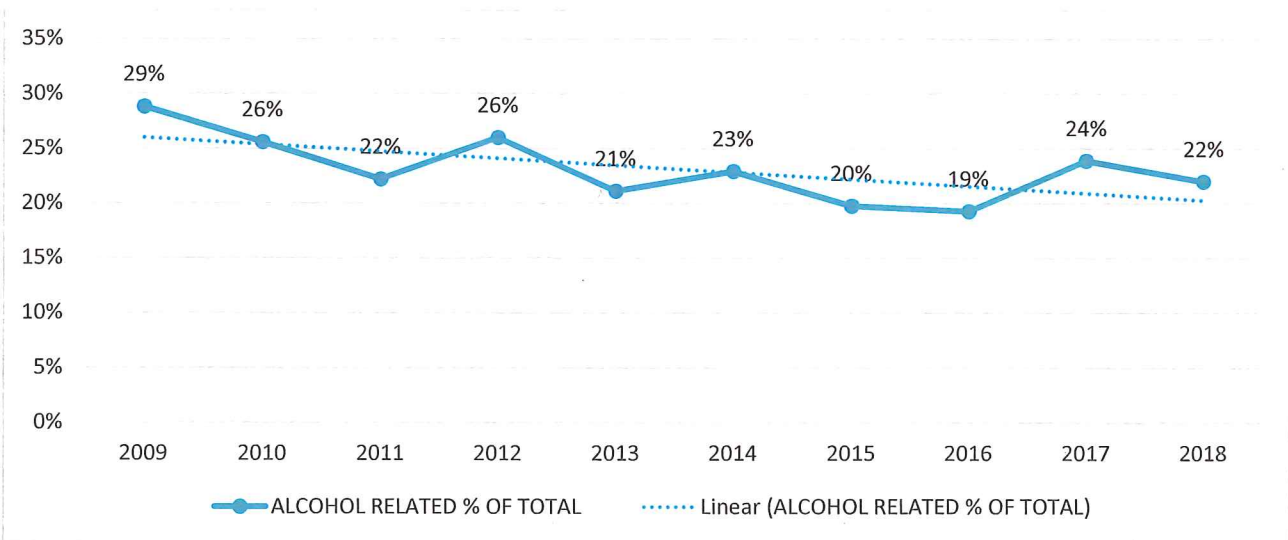

- From 2009 to 2018, 23% of serious injuries on NT roads have been alcohol related.
- As with fatalities, males (72%) are over-represented in alcohol related road serious injuries.
- Alcohol related serious injuries occur approximately equally between urban (48%) and rural areas (52%).

*Injured road users who were involved in a crash where at least one driver / rider involved had a BAC of 0.05 and over in their system.
