Housing Accommodation Support Initiative (NT HASI)

1. What is the status of the NT HASI?

NT HASI is currently operational in Darwin and Palmerston.

2. What KPIs is it meeting?

- All clients engage in a needs assessment and have in place an Individual Recovery Plan.
- Engagement in regular meetings with Department of Health, Top End Mental Health Services and Department of Local Government, Housing and Community Development i.e. Steering Committee, referral review panel.
- Conduct recovery focused activities in line with individualised service packages.
- Conduct group based and individualised activities that encourage independent living skills, personal and social development.
- Provision of support to people in all aspects of household management to sustain their public housing tenancies.

3. What budget allocation does it currently have?

\$900 000 per annum

4. How many department officers work on it?

There is no specific FTE allocated to NT HASI. Department of Health staff are involved in a service development capacity (contract monitoring/compliance, ongoing service improvement, grant payments etc.) and also as members on the NT HASI Steering Committee (bimonthly meetings). Clinical case managers from Top End Mental Health Services engage with NT HASI to work with their clients to provide specialist clinical mental health care.
