Subject: Cavenagh Street Bus Stop tender

QUESTION:

In relation to the bus stop tender of \$432 000, did it go out to a tender and what tier tender was that and who got the tender?

ANSWER:

The contract with Territoria Civil for Garramilla Boulevard / Tiger Brennan Drive included much of the cost associated with the Cavenagh Street bus stop.

In addition to this work, a number of smaller procurements were required for the bus stop including:

- Traffic Impact Assessment (Aurecon) – Single tender, Tier 1. To inform the consultation on short and long term options for bus services.
- CCTV security cameras (Security & Technology) Police period contract moving Smith Street CCTV cameras and installing required cameras for Cavenagh Street.
- Electronic Bus Totems (Mercury Innovation) – Single Select tender, Tier 2.
- Road Safety Audit (Top End Traffic Solutions) – Single tender, Tier 1. The audit was undertaken by an experienced traffic engineer to ensure no inherent safety risks were built into the works and surrounding areas.
- Conformance Testing - (Coffey Testing, RMG Geotechnical). This testing was to ensure compliance with specification requirements was undertaken through a period contract.
