Environment division of the Department of Lands, Planning and the Environment as of 1 January 2013 – public servant numbers

How many public servants were employed in the Environment division of the Department of Lands, Planning and the Environment as of 1 January 2013 in the following categories:

- Full time or the equivalent;
- Part time or the equivalent;
- On temporary contracts;
- At a lower classification than they were on 25 August 2012.

Response:

As at 1 January 2013, the Northern Territory Environment Protection Authority (NT EPA), of the Department of Lands, Planning and the Environment had:

- 37 full-time equivalent employees;
- 41 employees (based on headcount).

The number of public servants employed in the NT EPA in the following categories were:

- 36 full time;
- 5 part time;
- 7 on temporary contracts;
- Nil at a lower nominal classification than they were on 25 August 2012.

The above figures are calculated on headcount and exclude Board Members and Statutory Office Holders.
