- As at 24 August 2012, the number of public service staff employed in the Indigenous Advancement division of the former Department of Housing, Local Government and Regional Services was as follows:
 - 113.3 full time or the equivalent;
 - 60.5 part time or the equivalent; and
 - 36 full time equivalent on temporary contracts.
- During October 2012, the role of the Northern Territory Coordinator-General for Remote Services was being performed by the acting Chief Executive of the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement.

- On 19 October 2012, staff from the shared services Policy unit were transferred to the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement.
- As at 31 October 2012, the number of public service staff employed in the Indigenous Advancement division of the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement were as follows:
 - 118.9 full time or the equivalent;
 - 63.5 part time or the equivalent; and
 - 34.3 full time equivalent on temporary contracts.
