Bakewell Primary School - Kiss and Go Zone

During the Estimates Hearings on Wednesday 15 June 2022, the Shadow Minister for Education asked Minister Lawler (Minister for Education and Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics) about the Federal Labor election promise to fund parking spaces and kiss and go zones at the Bakewell Primary School to make it safer. Minister Lawler stated that design work has been done and that DIPL will work with the Federal Government regarding funding.

- 1. The Minister stated the design work by DIPL had been undertaken. What date will this design be released to the school?
- 2. What date will the tender for the works be released?
- 3. What is the estimated completion date for the project?
- 4. How much will these works cost?
- 5. How does this cost compare with other school kiss and go zones?
- 6. If the Federal Government funding promise falls short of the total costs, when will the NTG allocate funding to complete the project?
