Mr Guyula to the Minister for Education:

**Education KPIs**

- 1. What is the NTCET attainment rate for remote Aboriginal students in the NT in 2022?**
- 2. Why do KPI's not differentiate remote Aboriginal information? Could you please provide the KPI estimates for 2022-23 (as shown in budget paper 3, page 127) for remote Aboriginal students?**

**Answer to Questions 1 & 2:**

Key performance indicators (KPI) for the agency in budget paper 3 are set at a high level of aggregation, it is not possible for these published KPIs to disaggregate for all priority cohorts, however KPIs for the Aboriginal cohort are separated out across most Department of Education KPIs to ensure that results are kept in focus.

The Northern Territory Certificate of Education and Training (NTCET) attainment rate is a new measure introduced into the budget paper in 2023 to ensure accountability in achieving NTCET results for young people starting Year 12 in Northern Territory Government schools. The NTCET attainment rate based on student geolocation is not a measure currently used, and is therefore not readily available to be reported.
