Mr Maley to the Minister for Police:

Alcohol Harm Reductions Act - Offences

Part 6 of the *Alcohol Harm Reductions Act* includes the following:

42 Offence to supply alcohol to persons subject to prohibition

(1) A person commits an offence if:

- (a) the person intentionally supplies a substance to another person; and
- (b) the substance is alcohol and the person has knowledge of that circumstance; and
- (c) the other person is subject to a prohibition mentioned in section 128(1) of the *Liquor Act 2019* and the person has knowledge, or ought reasonably to have knowledge, of that circumstance.

Maximum penalty: 100 penalty units.

2. How many people have been convicted with a breach of section 42 (as above) in the calendar years:
