WRITTEN QUESTION

Mr Maley to the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics:

Howard Springs Facility – Individual Contractors

The following questions were asked as part of Written Question 604, with the response stating that the contracts are managed through the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics (DIPL).

The questions are therefore now re-submitted to the appropriate Minister:

1. How many different individual contractors attended the formerly named Howard Springs Centre for National Resilience (the site) for repairs and maintenance during the time of the housing of the flood evacuees up to 15 September 2023 or when DIPL was no longer responsible for contractors at the site due to the site being leased to the Department of Defence?

Please list the contractors and detail the work undertaken.

2. How many different individual contractors attended the site for repairs and maintenance at the centre after the housing of the flood evacuees up to 15 September 2023 or when DIPL was no longer responsible for contractors at the site due to the site being leased to the Department of Defence?

Please list the contractors and detail the work undertaken.

3. What is the total cost of all contracts managed by DIPL for repairs and maintenance at the site during the time of the housing of the flood evacuees up to 15 September 2023 or when DIPL was no longer responsible for contractors at the site due to the site being leased to the Department of Defence?

Please show separate totals against each contractor.

4. What is the total cost of all contracts managed by DIPL for repairs and maintenance at the site after the housing of the flood evacuees up to 15 September 2023 or when DIPL was no longer responsible for contractors at the site due to the site being leased to the Department of Defence?

Please show separate totals against each contractor.

In response to questions 1 to 4, the pertinent information has been outlined in written questions 604 and 660.

Addressing the request to ascertain and furnish individual contractor attendance at the site over the specified period would necessitate a thorough review of the site attendance log, thereby posing significant administrative burden. This is not effective use of administrative time.
