The Legislative Scrutiny Committee invites submissions to its inquiry into the Attorney-General Legislation Amendment (Boards, Committees and Statutory Offices) Bill 2026. The Committee encourages all interested people and organisations to provide their comments and feedback on the Bill.

The Committee is to inquire into and report on:

- (i) whether the Assembly should pass the Bill;
- (ii) whether the Assembly should amend the Bill;
- (iii) whether the Bill has sufficient regard to the rights and liberties of individuals; and
- (iv) whether the Bill has sufficient regard to the institution of Parliament.
