Question: **Who was consulted on the Tiwi Islands prior to the take-away licence at Milikapiti being granted?**

Answer:

In 2014, the nominee of the Milikapiti Sport and Social Club Inc (the Club) applied for a permanent variation to the Club's licence so as to authorise the sale of take-away alcohol.

The then Director-General of Licensing, through officers from the Department of Business Licensing NT division, undertook consultations in the community over a six month period. Community representation also included the local council and the Tiwi Land Council.

Additionally, the NT Police and the Department of Health were consulted as well as the Federal Minister for Indigenous Affairs, Senator the Hon Nigel Scullion.
