Mr CHAIRMAN: I will get you to restate the question for Hansard, Leader of the Opposition.

Mr MILLS: The Commonwealth government has given \$98.8m which will result in 200 additional teachers between 2008-12. What is the contribution of the Northern Territory government in relation to the 200 additional teachers over the same period?

Mr CHAIRMAN: Minister, are you prepared to take that on notice?

Ms SCRYMGOUR: Yes.

Mr CHAIRMAN: I allocate that question number 4.4.

ANSWER:

The contribution of the Northern Territory Government in relation to the 200 additional teachers between 2008-12 is:

- provision of the housing infrastructure in NT remote communities at a cost of approx \$450k per house.
- additional school infrastructure and resourcing costs required as a result of additional teaching capacity at the school.
- additional departmental overhead costs to support the additional staffing numbers.
