Answer: The Department’s comment on the Draft Notice of Intent for Tiger Brennan Extension recommended development of a Construction Environment Management Plan, Erosion and Sediment Control Plan and Stormwater Management Plan.

The project’s Clearing Plan contains a commitment for rehabilitation of disturbed areas. It also states that an Erosion and sediment Control Plan will be finalised by 1 August 2009.
