In the twelve months since the commencement of section 7A of the Bail Act on 10 December 2008 1,087 alleged offenders charged with a serious violence offence applied for bail.

Of these alleged offenders:

- · 784 (72%) were refused bail; and
- $\cdot$  303 (28%) were granted bail.
