Ms CARNEY: Of the 16 intake workers currently employed in the Central Intake Team, how many are employed at the level of P1, and how many are employed at the level of P2?

Mr VATSKALIS: That is a specific question?

Ms CARNEY: Yes. The reason I ask is that it is clear that the Children's Commissioner and the Tolhurst report said that the intake team was not coping, and it had serious, indeed, severe, capacity problems. At the time of the Children's Commissioner report, there were, I understand, eight, three of whom were P2s and the remainder were P1s, and I would have thought that if you were looking to increase capacity and expertise of child protection workers to make the system work better, you would be looking at getting more P2s.
