Question: What is the greatest amount of rent arrears?

Answer: According to the information recorded in the Tenancy Management System TMS), as at the end of March 2011, the greatest amount of rent in arrears for a tenant was $\$ 6918.83$

The actual amount of debt recorded in TMS was been largely inflated by the fact they did not return their rental rebate form and were being charged market rent.

The rebate information was provided in May 2011 and the rent adjusted. As at 30 June 2011 the total arrears for the same tenancy was $\$ 1,474.83$. The remainder of the rent arrears owed by this tenancy is currently subject to an Agreement to Pay at an amount of $\$ 60$ a fortnight
