Alliances are undertaking all new houses, rebuilds and refurbishments under SIHIP. Shires are undertaking repairs and maintenance under property management service level agreements with Territory Housing, and a number of Indigenous enterprises are currently engaged by alliances to assist with delivery of the refurbishment program.
