Mrs Finocchiaro to the Minister for Housing & Community Development:

## 33 Banksia Street, Zuccoli

 Would you please advise what is being constructed by Territory Housing at 33 Banksia Street, Zuccoli?

Six, single bedroom, public housing dwellings in three, single storey, buildings are being constructed at 33 Banksia Street, Zuccoli.

 Would you please provide a plan, if any, for the planned construction at 33 Banksia Street, Zuccoli?

The plans submitted with the Development Application and exhibited for public comment/feedback are attached.

3. If public housing units are being constructed, can you please advise what cohort these houses/units will be leased to; for example, seniors, families, etc?

All new urban public housing is designed to be adaptable to cater for a wide range of tenants, including seniors and people living with disability, however, not exclusively. Since the dwellings are single bedroom, it is unlikely that families will be tenants in this complex.

4. What is the expected timeframe for completion?

The construction timeframe is estimated at 33 weeks, with an expected completion date of early February 2019.

5. If residents are concerned by the development, what opportunities for feedback do those residents have?

The opportunity for residents to provide feedback has now closed as per the Development Application process set out by the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics.


The Development Application was submitted with the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics and was advertised in the local newspaper for a period of 14 days. A pink sign was also erected on site to inform local residents that a development application had been lodged. The exhibition period was from Friday, 29 June 2018 – to 12 Midnight Friday, 13 July 2018, and the submission was open for public comment/feedback during this time through Northern Territory Land Information Systems.
