Office of the Public Guardian Annual Report

- Please explain why there was such a high proportion of adults under Private Guardianship in Darwin, compared to the proportion of Private Guardianship in Alice Springs and Katherine. See graph on page 35.
- 2. Page 45 of the report shows an estimate of 448 Aboriginal people under adult guardianship for the 2016-17 year and an actual number of 543. The estimate for the 2017-18 year was then 493, a figure lower than the previous year's actual, and yet the actual figure for 2017-18 was 548. What was the reason for the anticipated decline in Aboriginal people under adult guardianship and why did this not eventuate?

RESPONSE

- The proportion of adults under Private Guardianship in Darwin compared to other regions, is reflective of the general population characteristics, access to services and proportion of people with a disability residing in the region.
- The estimate for 2017/18 of 493 was reported in the BP3 paper, published in April 2017, and the figures cannot be changed to reflect the actual figures.
