Mr Higgins to the Minister for Education:

Woolianna School Demountable

- 1. What are the future arrangements following the removal of the demountable school from the site?
- 2. What will remain at the site and what remediation has been agreed upon with the owners of the land, the Daly River Progress Association?
- 3. With the current ongoing lease, what arrangements are in place for supply of water to the school?
- 4. What are the costs to the school / government associated with the supply of water to the school?

ANSWER

- 1. The new transportable classroom at Woolianna School was installed in December 2018. The previous transportable classroom was removed from the site.
- 2. The Daly River Progress Association was consulted through the process. The new transportable is located in the same position as the transportable that was removed.
- 3. Woolianna School runs on rain water and town water trucked in from Batchelor. The water is stored in three rainwater tanks. Tank one is a cement tank that holds up to 26 000L, tank two is a green plastic tank that holds up to 26 000L and tank three is a metal tank that holds up to 8 000L.
- 4. The cost of the water supply is a school operational responsibility. The cost of the water for 2018 was \$11 750.
