Ms Walker to the Minister for Housing:

Public Servant Numbers – Department of Housing

1. Would you please advise how many public servants were employed;
 - Full time or the equivalent;
 - 470.9 full time or the equivalent;
 - Part time or the equivalent;
 - 14.3 part time or the equivalent; and
 - On temporary contracts,
 - 87.2 full time equivalent on temporary contracts.

in the Department of Housing on 24 August 2012.

 - It should be noted that the Department of Housing did not exist as a separate entity prior to the latest Northern Territory election on 25 August 2012, but was a part of the Department of Housing, Local Government and Regional Services.
 - The numbers quoted above refer to those public servants attached to the Housing business unit, together with public servants employed for delivery of corporate services as a share services model to the new agencies of the Department of Housing, the Department of Local Government and the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement on 24 August 2012.
 - On 19 October 2012, staff from the shared services policy unit and legislation were transferred to the Department of Local Government and the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement.

 - Part time or the equivalent;
 - 13.2 part time or the equivalent; and
