Mr Edgington to the Minister for Mining and Industry:

Darwin Turf Club Grandstand Grant (Industry Support Program Funding)

- The Department of Trade, Business and Innovation Annual Report of 2018-19 states under the heading "Industry Support Program Funding to Peak Industry Bodies to Assist with Industry Sector Development" that the Darwin Turf Club (DTC) received funding of \$12 million (\$13.2 million including GST at page 115). Why was the grant funding paid from this program, when DTC is not a peak industry body?
- 2. How was the \$12M figure arrived at for the grant?
- 3. Why was the usual practice of withholding part of a grant not applied to the grant to DTC for the grandstand?
- 4. Who recommended to Government that the grant to the DTC for the grandstand be paid in a lump sum?
- 5. How many industry support program or capital grants of \$12+ million has the Gunner Government awarded, to who and for what amount from 1 January 2019 to date?
 - a. How many of those industry support program and capital grants were paid as a one-off lump sum?
 - b. How many of those industry support program and capital grants did not require the receiver of the grant to contribute to the project?
- 6. What is the process for industry support program and capital grant funding?

Answer:
