Mr Maley to the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics:

Coolalinga Road Safety Upgrades

A fact sheet dated February 2021 on your Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics (DIPL) web page states that a construction tender for the proposed Coolalinga Road safety upgrades is expected to be released in October 2021 and subsequent works expected to commence in 2022.

Questions:

- 1. When will the construction tender for these works be released? What has caused the delay? Will this also result in a delay in commencing the works in 2022?
- 2. You have already spent \$396,973.50 on the design and documentation. What is your construction budget to complete these works?
- 3. Do you have a budget contingency for any possible budget blowouts? How much is your budget contingency?
- 4. Once this project has commenced, how long do you anticipate the works that impact on traffic and pedestrians in Coolalinga, will take?
- 5. What changes have been made to final design documentation as shown on the DIPL web page fact sheet, since the public consultation phase?
- 6. Why didn't you consult the public and stakeholders about these changes?
- 7. In any other major capital, on-off exit-entry ramps onto a major highway would be expected. Why have you designed 3 sets of traffic lights on the Stuart Highway within a few hundred metres of each other?
