Principal and Teacher Vacancies

1. How many principal positions are currently vacant in Northern Territory schools and how long have they been vacant? Please specify by school.

There are no current principal vacancies in NT government schools.

- 2. How many Northern Territory principals have left their positions in the 2022/23 financial year to date through:
 - a. resignation,
 - b. termination,
 - c. retirement,
 - d. transfer to another NT school.
 - e. transfer to a non-school based role?

6. How many teaching positions are currently vacant in Northern Territory Schools, and how long have they been vacant? Please specify by school.

As at 3 February 2023, there were 32 reported teacher vacancies across all NT Government schools. For specific vacancies, see Attachment A.

- 7. How many Northern Territory teachers have left their positions in the 2022/23 financial year to date through:
 - a. resignation,
 - b. termination,
 - c. retirement,
 - d. transfer to another NT school,
 - e. transfer to a non-school based role?

In the 2022-23 financial year, there were 209 classroom teachers who left their position through resignation, end of contract or retirement.

The data is as at 7 February 2023. It may include employees who have had multiple periods of employment throughout the year.

8. How many teacher positions have been recruited to in the 2022/23 financial year to date in Northern Territory Government schools? How long was the average recruitment action? How long was the longest?

In the 2022-23 financial year, there were 421 classroom teacher commencements.

This figure includes teachers who have ceased and re-commenced on different contracts within the financial year.

With school autonomy, school leaders undertake the recruitment of classroom teachers; the department does not have visibility of the length of time of all recruitment actions.

The NT Government Recruitment and Selection Policy recommends that selection processes be finalised within a maximum of 6 weeks from the closing date of advertising, unless there are exceptional circumstances.

9. What has been the total cost to recruit to teacher position vacancies in the 2022/23 financial year to date?

With school autonomy, school leaders undertake the recruitment of classroom teachers to their schools.

Schools leaders can choose to advertise teaching positions via the NT Government jobs site which costs \$189.01 per job, with standalone media advertising for additional fees.

Classroom teaching positions are not required to be advertised via the NT Government jobs site and can be listed on the Teach in the Territory website with no cost to schools. This is the preferred option by schools to promote teaching positions.

Further information would be required to define "the total cost to recruit to teaching vacancies" as costs could include advertising, relocation, marketing strategies etc.

10. How many current teaching positions are permanent and how many are temporary contracts?

As at 8 February 2023, 65% of classroom teachers were permanent and 35% were temporary.

11. How many people with teaching qualifications are currently employed in nonteaching roles in the Department of Education?

There is no system or process to capture those employees working in corporate roles with teaching qualifications.

Recruitment to corporate positions is based on the selection criteria of the position description, and not necessarily on professional qualifications as a teacher. The merit selection process is followed to select a successful applicant and professional qualifications are not captured outside the panel report.
