## **Education funding**

- 1. Budget Paper 3 shows that in 2024-25 \$72 million has been allocated to support government and non-government schools to achieve Schooling Resource Standard targets under the Statement of Intent for the Better and Fairer Schools Agreement. Regarding this \$72 million please provide a breakdown of how it will be spent. Please include how much has been allocated to:
  - a. Government education through the School Resourcing Model *excluding* centralised costs.
  - b. Government education through the School Resourcing Model *for* centralised school costs,
  - c. Non-government schools
  - d. Agency programs and corporate units
  - e. Any other allocations

The 2024-25 published budget for the Department of Education (the department) is \$1.335 billion, comprising of:

- \$931.0m for government education (69.7% of budget)
- \$316.2m for non-government education (23.7% of budget)
- \$87.9m for corporate and shared services (6.6% of budget).
- 2. Budget Paper 3 shows that from 2024-2025 the government education budget increases from \$841 million to \$930 million. Please provide a breakdown of how this funding will be allocated. Please include how much has been allocated to:
  - a. Government education through the School Resourcing Model excluding centralised costs.

  - d. Any other allocations
