### **QUESTION:**

We understand the rationale for merging agencies, but the budget paper no longer includes outcome and performance indicators of key sections such as sport and recreation. Parks and Wildlife merged with the Department of Tourism and Culture, yet they still have their own section in Budget Paper Three, whereas Sport and Rec. appears not to. Are there outcomes and performance indicators for Sport and Recreation?

### **ANSWER:**

Sport and Recreation is a highly valued and a key area of public policy for this Government.

The Budget Paper 3 2017-18 Output: Tourism and Culture reflects the amalgamation of Sport and Recreation, Parks and Wildlife Commission, Arts and Museums, Heritage and Tourism NT into the Department of Tourism and Culture.

The Territory Wildlife Parks is a Government Business Division and as such continues to be reported as a separate entity in Budget Paper 3.

Key Performance Indicators for the Tourism and Culture Output as reported in Budget Paper 3 include Sport and Recreation.
