Question: Could the department please provide the cost breakdown for each of the new health clinics that have been delivered since 30 August 2016, and for the upgrades to health clinics since 30 August 2016? In that breakdown, please identify the split between Federal and Territory funding.

Answer:

Health and Hospital Fund

- \$50.29 million was allocated by the Australian Government for seven new Northern Territory Remote Health Centres and the upgrade of four existing centres, as part of its Health and Hospitals Fund.
- Four new build health clinics and upgrades to four existing health clinics were completed prior to August 2016.
- The remaining three new build health clinics were completed after August 2016.

Health Centre	Construction	Budget	Status
Galiwinku	New Build	\$6.7 million	Completed March 2017 Services commenced May 2017
Numbulwar	New Build	\$7.14 million	Completed March 2017 Services commenced August 2017
Robinson River	New Build	\$4.77 million	Completed October 2017 Services commenced December 2017

Minor New Works Program

- Upgrades to existing Health Centres are funded through the NTG Health Minor New Works programs.
- Completed upgrades since August 2016 total \$2.2 million.
- Projects in progress are estimated at a total of \$2.3 million.
- These figures include projects that were funded as part of the 2016/17 Stimulus program.
