Question: 7-4
Could the minister please provide a list of current goods and services being exported?

Answer: This relates to the export, who is exporting what where. In 2014-15, the Northern Territory's top five goods, excluding services – export partners were Japan at \$2.7bn, representing 44% of exports; China was \$1.4bn, representing 22% of exports; Thailand was \$636m, representing 10% of exports. \$409m for Indonesia and \$158m for Vietnam. That is correct, 3%. So the key exports exported included LNG, minerals, petroleum and live cattle. The Northern Territory's main export services were: personal travel, excluding education, was \$303m, which represents 40% of services exports; business travel \$165m, representing 21% of services exports; and government services, at \$121m, representing 15% of service exports.
