Mrs. Finocchiaro to the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice:

Courts and Tribunals

- 1. Are there any plans for an additional Supreme Court judge to be added in Alice Springs?
- 2. Funding for lower courts and tribunals is about \$706,000 lower than the budget for 2017-18; what accounts for that reduction?
- 3. Has there been a reduction in matters being considered?
- 4. How much of that funding is for NTCAT specifically and what is the increase in NTCAT matters expected for this financial year, as compared with last year?

Answers

- 1. No.
- 2. The 2017-18 Budget included \$1.24m in one-off stimulus funding which was not provided in 2018-19 combined with minor infrastructure program and related adjustments of \$0.13m. This was offset by the addition in 2018-19 of minor program, CPI and salary related parameter adjustments of \$0.67m.
- 3. There is an assumption that this question only relates to the Local Court. Yes there has been a reduction, but not consider to be significant, from 21 032 Court Lodgements in 2016-17 to 20 679 in 2017-18.
- 4. Northern Territory Civil Administrative Tribunal (NTCAT) funding is \$3.284m. It is estimated that NTCAT matters may increase from 2325 in 2017-18 financial year to approximately 2790 this financial year.
