Mr Higgins to the Minister for Tourism, Sport and Culture:

Daly River Oval

Would you please advise:

- 1. Whether the delay to the upgrade of Daly River Oval is due to the presence of asbestos?
- 2. Whether the removal will be covered by the original budget?
- 3. Whether it is true that \$1 million has already been spent on this project?

ANSWERS

- On 13 June 2019 the contractor working on Nauiyu Community Oval, identified asbestos containing material while undertaking excavation. Works were suspended and the contaminated area made safe whilst a management plan was developed.
- 2. The estimated cost for the removal and appropriate disposal of the asbestos by a licensed contractor is \$100 000. Victoria Daly Regional Council was granted a \$61 000 to complete remediation works, funded through the 2019-20 Remote Sporting Infrastructure Program and the remaining \$39 000 has been allocated from the project's contingency.
- 3. Upgrades to the recreation hall are complete and oval upgrades are close to completion. The total cost for both projects is \$1.061 million.
