

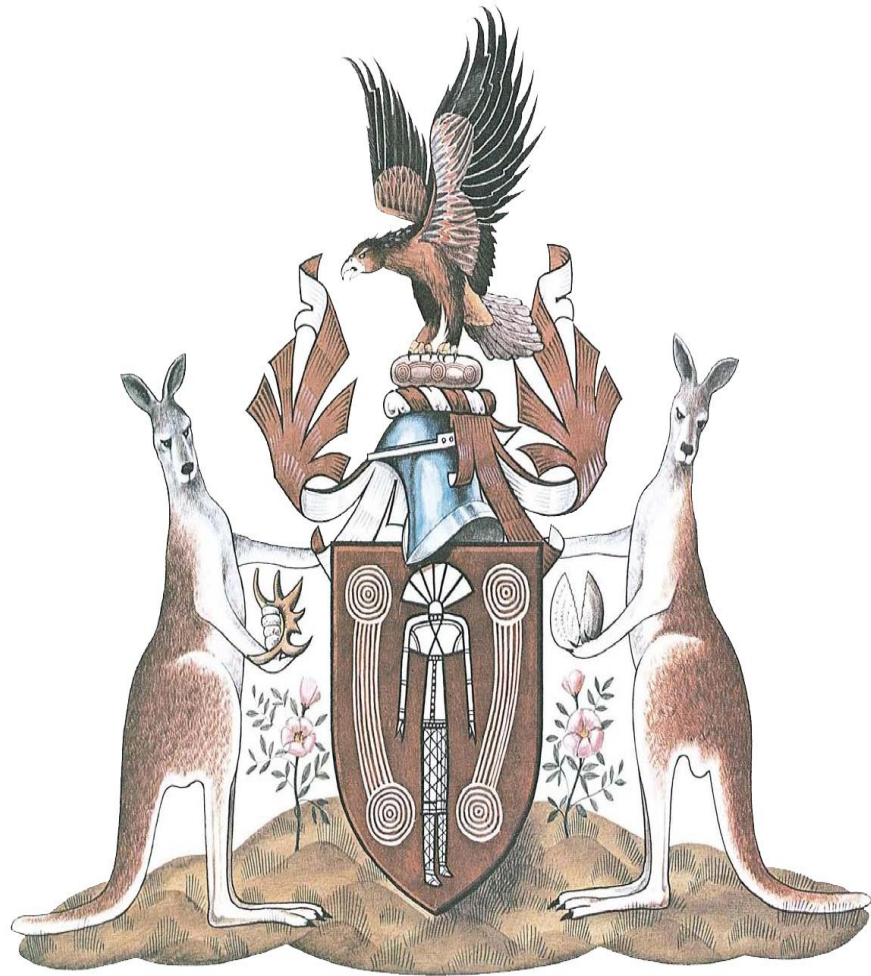

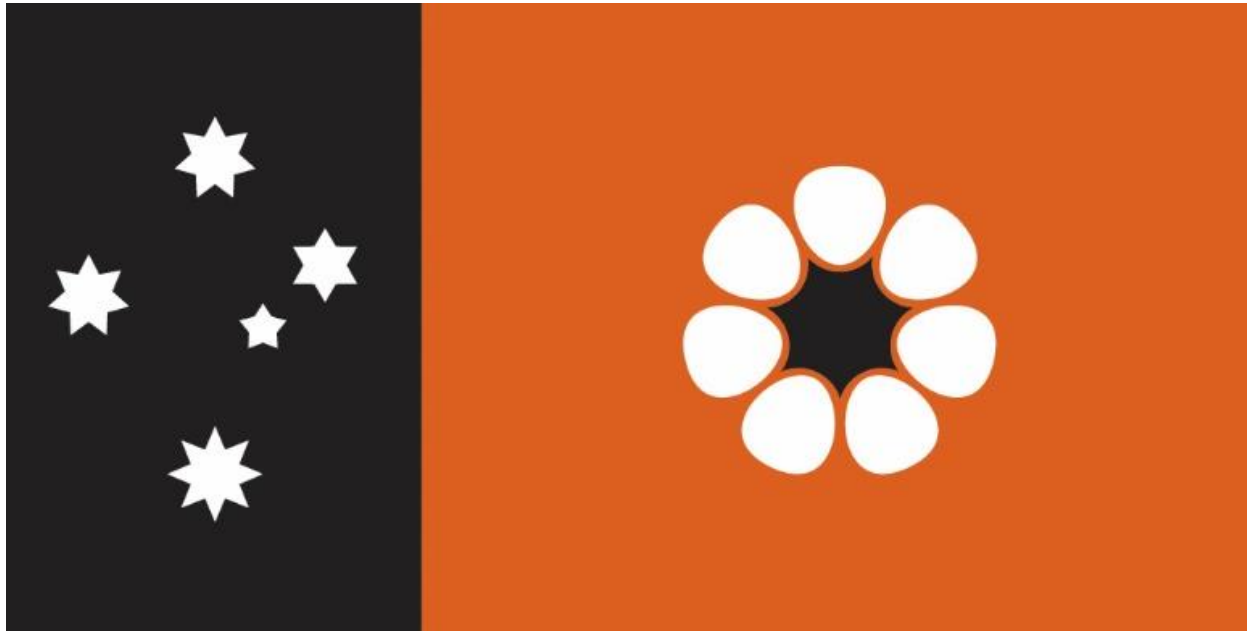

Describe the flag of the Northern Territory



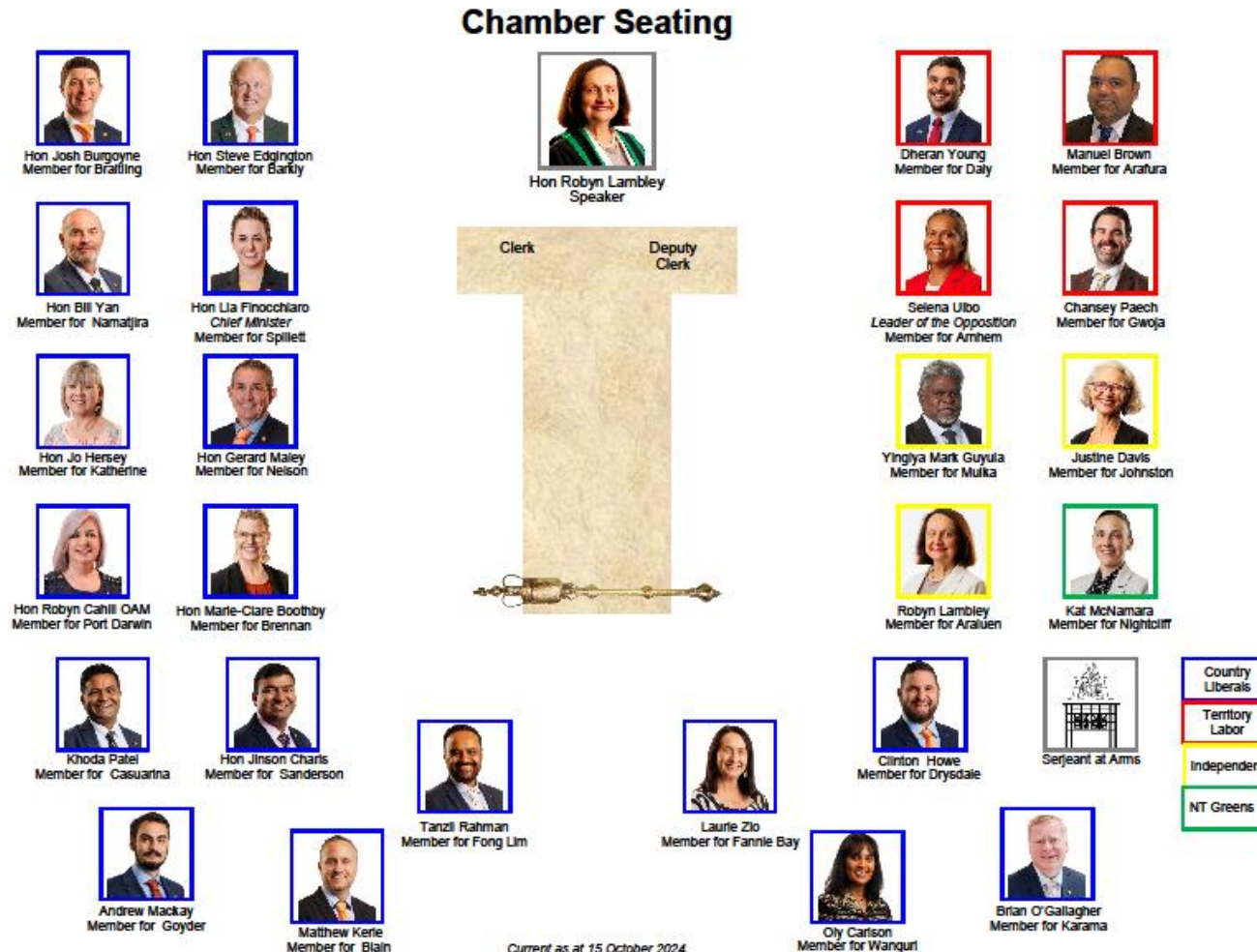


The number of members in the Legislative Assembly is:

Making a Law in the Northern Territory

LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

1st READING

The bill (an idea for a new law) is introduced in to the Legislative Assembly.

2nd READING

Members debate and vote on the main idea of the bill.

Consideration in detail

Members look closely at the bill, and may make changes.

3rd READING

Members vote on the final version of the bill.

Assent

The Northern Territory Administrator signs the bill.
