# **Explanation of reporting**

Pay periods reported have been selected as closest to the dates in the question. Figures include staff on paid leave such as long service, maternity or sick leave.

- 1. FTE figures represent the portion of hours staff work, compared to full-time hours of 36.45 hours per week (eg. an employee working 4 out of 5 days is 80% of an FTE).
- 2. Total FTE for the department involves adding together all FTE figures (eg. two staff working 50% equates to 1 FTE).
- 3. Part Time staff are employed under casual, permanent or contract arrangements and are included in each Employment Category, however are also reported separately for information.
