A:

- By "public servants", it is assumed the question is intended to exclude the Government Business Division, Territory Discoveries, as these employees are not employed under the *NT Public Sector 2010 2013 Enterprise Agreement*. Employees that transferred to Tourism NT following the August 2012 election (i.e. from Major Events) have also been excluded to provide for meaningful comparisons.
- Tourism Advisory Board members have been excluded from this data.
