The Territory Coordinator Bill is an outrageous breach of the rights of citizens in a democracy to be involved in decision making processes.

Of particular concern is the quashing minority voices. Minority voices are frequently excluded in traditional democratic structures, and yet they almost without exception have invaluable and important contributions to make to culture, society and environmental safety.

As a mother, grandmother, professional mental health recovery worker and long time advocate for mother earth, I urge you to install proper processes for extensive and unhurried consultation with the appropriate people, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders, scientists, doctors, lawyers and all those who are invested in the health, safety and wellbeing of current and future generations.
