I am writing to express my strong opposition to the proposed Voluntary Assisted Dying (VAD) legislation in the NT. While acknowledging the difficult circumstances individuals facing terminal illness can experience, I believe this legislation poses significant risks to our society and the most vulnerable among us.

There are potential concerns on many levels and particular situation and urge you to consider the profound ethical implications and potential negative consequences of VAD and prioritise policies that support and protect the dignity and sanctity of all human life. I encourage you to focus on improving access to comprehensive and compassionate palliative care for all. I work as a Chaplain in Palliative Care Unit and often journey with patients, families. There are deep concerns if this Legislation is approved.
