To amend the Public Service Ordinance 1976.

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Service Ordinance (No. 2) 1976. Short title
2. The Public Service Ordinance 1976 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance
3. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after sub-section (1) the following sub-section: Commencement  
"(1A) Section 39(4) shall come into operation on the date of commencement of the Public Service Ordinance (No. 2) 1976."
4. Section 39 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section: Arrangements for transfer of Australian Public Servants to the Territory Service  
"(4) For the purposes of Division 11 of Part III of the Public Service Act 1922, the Commissioner may appoint persons to be employees."

To amend the Transfer of Powers Ordinance 1976

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Transfer of Powers Ordinance (No. 2) 1976. Short title
2. The Transfer of Powers Ordinance 1976 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance
- 3.(1) Section 2(1) of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "Subject to sub-section (2)" and substituting "Subject to sub-sections (2) and (3)". Commencement of Principal Ordinance
- (2) Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:  
"(3) The amendments made by reference to Parts I and IV of Schedule 1 to the Supply of Services Ordinance and the amendments made by reference to Parts I and III of Schedule 2 to Regulations under that Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette as the date upon which those amendments shall come into operation."
4. Notwithstanding section 2 of the Principal Ordinance, sections 1 and 2 of the Principal Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date on which the Principal Ordinance received assent. Effect of this Ordinance
