for

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Justices Ordinance

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

l. This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Justices Ordinance</u> 1976.

Short title

2. The <u>Justices Ordinance</u> is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Principal Ordinance

3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the date of commencement of the <u>Magistrates Ordinance</u>.

Commencement

4. Section 4A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "A reference in this Ordinance" and substituting "Unless the contrary intention appears, a reference in this Ordinance".

References to Magistrates

5.(1) Section 10(1) of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (b).

Appointment of Justices

- (2) Section 10(3) of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraphs (b), (c) and (d).
- (3) Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (4).

Oaths of office, etc.

- 6.(1) Section 11(1) of the Principal Ordinance is smended by omitting ", a Special Magistrate or a Stipendiary Magistrate".
- (2) Section 11 of the Frincipal Ordinance is amended by omitting subsection (5).

Repeal of sections 12 and 13

To amend the <u>Territory Parks and Wildlife</u> Conservation Ordinance

B E it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Territory</u> Short Parks and <u>Wildlife Conservation</u> Ordinance (No 3) 1976. title
- 2. The <u>Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation</u> Principal Ordinance is in this Ordinance referred to as the Ordinance Principal Ordinance.
- 3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a Commencement date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette.
- 4. Section 12(6) of the Principal Ordinance is Parks and amended by omitting paragraphs (b) and (c) and reserves substituting established by

 "(b) the hed of any stream, lake inlet or other Administrator
 - "(b) the bed of any stream, lake, inlet or other Administrator water within the area; and in Council
 - (c) the subsoil beneath any such bed,".

To amend the <u>Public Service Ordinance</u> 1976.

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Service Ordinance (No. 2) 1976.

Short title

2. The <u>Public Service Ordinance</u> 1976 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Principal Ordinance

3. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after sub-section (1) the following sub-section:

Commencement

- "(1A) Section 39(4) shall come into operation on the date of commencement of the <u>Public Service Ordinance</u> (No. 2) 1976.".
- 4. Section 39 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thercof the following sub-section:
- "(4) For the purposes of Division 11 of Part III of the <u>Public Service Act</u> 1922, the Commissioner may appoint persons to be employees.".

To amend the <u>Transfer of Fowers</u> Ordinance 1976

B^E it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Transfer of Powers Ordinance (No. 2)</u> 1976.

Short title

2. The <u>Transfer of Powers</u>
Ordinance 1976 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Frincipal Ordinance.

Principal Ordinance

3.(1) Section 2(1) of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "Subject to sub-section (2)" and substituting "Subject to sub-sections (2) and (3)".

Commencement of Principal Ordinance

- (2) Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:
- "(3) The amendments made by reference to Parts I and IV of Schedule 1 to the <u>Supply of Services Ordinance</u> and the amendments made by reference to Parts I and III of Schedule 2 to Regulations under that Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the <u>Gazette</u> as the date upon which those amendments shall come into operation.".
- 4. Notwithstanding section 2 of the Principal Ordinance, sections 1 and 2 of the Frincipal Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date on which the Principal Ordinance received assent.

Effect of this Ordinance
