Question

What does the Territory Government believe the impact will be on Territory students from the Commonwealth's changes to higher education funding and student support?

Answer

- As part of its Budget 2014-15, the Commonwealth Government has indicated it plans to reform the higher education sector. Until detailed legislation is available, the impacts outlined here are indicative only.
- These reforms will create greater choice for all students. The reforms that are most likely to affect students include:
 - changes to Commonwealth course subsidies and student contribution amounts
 - support for diploma, advanced diploma and associate degree courses –
 students will have the same access to Commonwealth subsidies as students
 studying bachelor degree course at public universities
 - support for students at all higher education institutions (currently students studying higher education courses at TAFE, private university or a private college are excluded from Commonwealth subsidies), and
 - changes affecting the repayment through the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP).
- CDU may need to do things differently and focus on its competitive advantages. A

strong focus of the Charles Darwin University/Northern Territory Government Partnership is to develop further the points of difference and position the Northern Territory as a destination of choice, nationally and internationally.

- As a dual sector university, Charles Darwin University currently offers seamless
 pathways between vocational education and training and higher education. The
 additional support for diplomas and sub-bachelor course may improve pathways to
 higher education.
