## SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION NO. 39 OF 2016

NORTHERN TERRITORY CIVIL AND ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL  
REGULATIONS 2016**Purpose**

To amend the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Regulations* by prescribing a new Schedule of Fees for the various functions of the Tribunal arising out of the conferral of new jurisdictions.

**Summary of key provisions**

Clause 3 of the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Regulations 2016* repeals the existing Schedule of Fees in the Regulations and inserts a new Schedule which sets out those fees now payable upon application to the Tribunal under jurisdiction conferred by the following Acts:

- a. *Small Claims Act* or *Fences Act*;
- b. *Anti-Discrimination Act*;
- c. *Health Practitioner Regulation (National Uniform Legislation) Act* or *Health Practitioners Act*;
- d. *Victims of Crime Assistance Act*;
- e. *Guardianship of Adults Act* or *Advance Personal Planning Act*;
- f. *Private Security Act*;
- g. An application under an Act specified in Part 2 or Part 3 or an application for review under section 140 of the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act*.

In addition, the Schedule also sets out increases fees for applications under the following Acts:

- a. *Residential Tenancies Act* or *Caravan Parks Act*;
- b. An application for any other proceeding under the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act*.

**Legislative Authority**

Section 155 of the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act*.
