**the majority of schools are managing these projects, including procurement, with guidance from DET and NTG procurement processes. 21 of the 98 Round 1 projects have commenced.

Roads

- 24 projects in total - eight complete, 11 to be completed by 26 June and five still have work to be completed - value of work completed \$3.7 million

Housing

- funding for upgrade of 175 existing properties and build 22 new homes
- 42 homes upgrades completed - contracts let for \$0.89 million for upgrade works
