Answer:

The Department of Housing, Local Government and Regional Services' Indigenous Essential Services Program provides essential services to 72 Indigenous communities and 67 outstations connected to the remote distribution networks. Services are delivered under contract to Indigenous Essential Services Pty Ltd, a wholly owned, not for profit, subsidiary of the Power Water Corporation (PWC).

In 2009-10 the diesel fuel usage across the 72 remote Indigenous communities was 28.1 mega litres, with a $\rm CO_2$ emission estimate of 75,870 tonnes per annum.
