Offences and Policing in the Darwin CBD and Mitchell St Darwin

- 1. In Mitchell St and the CBD in the years 2011/12 and 2012/13 (until 21 October 2013):
 - a. What were the numbers of arrests and reason for the arrests related to disturbance of the peace, fighting, resisting arrest, or any other offences related to alcohol fuelled violence?
 - b. What were the times and dates that these offences took place, especially Friday, Saturday and Sunday between midnight and 5 am?
 - c. How many people were held in protective custody and what dates and times did they occur?
 - d. How many people were given banning notices?
 - e. How many banning notices were given to repeat offenders?
 - f. How many banning notices were given to Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal people?
- 2. How many police normally patrol the CBD and Mitchell Street each day of the week between midnight and 5 am?
- 3. What was the cost to run Operation Omaha and how many police were involved?
